There were new meeting lists out (July 2019). The group discussed what to do with the old ones. It was agreed upon that for this month they would be destroyed (there was only 1 left). H&I will also replace their copies with the new versions. It was discussed whether or not there would be any sort of exchange program for homegroups to exchange their meetings lists versus having to re-buy the new ones (in an attempt to consider those homegroups that might not be able to afford to rebuy). Based on the price of meeting lists \$0.39/each, it was decided no such program needed to be implemented.

Sharing Session - Sharing session was waived by the group

Old business – As part of old business, Ron provided an update on the Outreach Ad Hoc Committee (see report). overall, in the past month they have gone to about 1/3 of the homegroups in the area. they collect information such as the address, whether or not they have a GSR, whether they want moer information on area, as well as confirming their meeting is reflected correctly on the website (meeting type, handicap accessible, etc.).

It was discussed that this group should be combined with Public Relations. A trusted servant asked if the group had any sort of information to pass along based on the groups they have met with, they did not.

The issue of the quantity of homegroups listed as needing support on the website was raised again. All homegroups are autonomous and have the right to read as much or as little from the GSR report as they like. A trusted servant mentioned that his homegroup prints out a list of those meetings needing support and has them out at their meeting (versus reading the list every time).

The ad hoc committee will continue to visit the homegroups in our area and hope to have this completed by next area service.

New business -

The new comer packets were available. There were 23 packets available and 20 homegroups in attendance when the discussion began. The group discussed what to do with those additional 3 packets. We consulted the minutes from last year to determine what was done then. For reference, last year all of the packets were handed out to present homegroups and then the remaining packets were brought to the following area service. At that time, any homegroups which did not get a packet last month, but were in attendance, had their names placed in a hat and drawn to distribute the remaining packets.

This year, since there were only 3 "extra", the group discussed providing them to homegroups that were usually there but happened not to be that week and/or groups that were represented by another attendee. A motion was drafted and passed to give the remaining three packages of hope to: Sharpsburg Group, Vets and Friends, and Garden of Hope. The packages were given to trusted servants who attended those meetings and could get it to them.

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




