If we take more than 10 business days (20 business days if you are a new customer, for electronic transfers occurring during the first 30 days after the first deposit is made to your account) to do this, we will credit your account for the amount you think is in error, so that you will have the use of the money during the time it takes us to complete our investigation.

[For other accounts, we investigate, and if we find we have made an error, we credit your account at the conclusion of our investigation.]

Calculating your Finance Charge

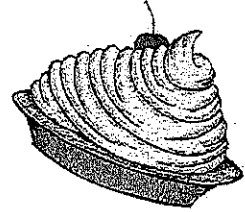
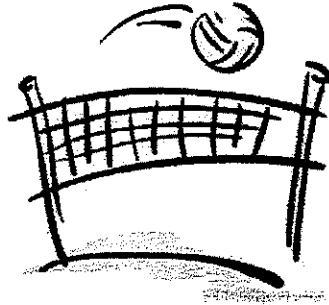

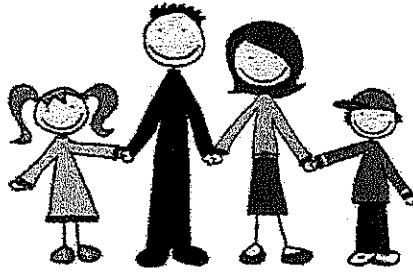
