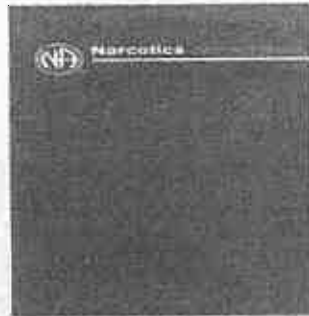
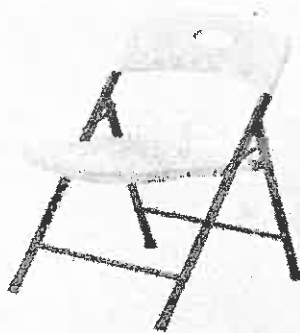

- Meetings were held on 4/14/24 and 5/19/24 they opened with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.
- We read the 12 Traditions & 12 Concepts.
- Took attendance and quorum was met for both meetings
- Area donations to the region totaled **\$276.62**.
- SWANA public relations now has a pop up sign out at Freedom Healthcare. The total cost of that banner was **\$273.91**.
- The H & I subcommittee now has a new Chairperson. We currently have commitments in 3 facilities:
